Ofsted will be carrying out 'deep dives' when inspecting schools from September 2019. It states in the framework that '*inspectors will often carry out a deep dive in mathematics*'. They will speak to '*the curriculum lead and teachers to understand where each lesson sits in the sequence of lessons*'.

The aim of these meetings is to equip teachers and mathematics subject leaders with understanding how to make choices about content and sequencing. We will look at:

- creating logical and linked journeys through learning, consolidation and depth;
- clustering mathematical statutory requirements to make the learning meaningful;
- connecting the maths curriculum with teaching, assessment and standards.

The sessions will take a workshop format and teachers will leave them with an overview of their upcoming unit of work prepared. Any teachers from any year groups from year 1 to 6 are welcome to any of the sessions. Teachers may wish to bring their laptops to type up their thoughts but we will also be using large paper and coloured pens to plan with. A teacher can attend any number of sessions.
