Each school needs to have confidence in the teacher assessment judgements at the end of Key Stage 1. Year 2 teachers need to feel skilled in making these judgements. During the three sessions, we will explore:

- ✓ the assessment statements for the end of KS1 in mathematics and what the implications are for the teaching in year 2
- ✓ how to decide if a child is working at the Expected Standard and how to get them there
- ✓ how to decide if a child is working at the Expected Standard with Greater Depth and what it means for 'rapid graspers' to be working at Greater Depth
- ✓ key understandings that children need in order to develop as good mathematicians
- ✓ promoting readiness for the next stage in children's mathematical learning

This course will be particularly useful for teachers who are new to year 2 but will also benefit any year 2 teacher or manager of KS1 or mathematics.
